Our puppies are mainly miniature to medium size (average weight 10-16kg) though occasionally we have bigger puppies up to standard poodle size.

What do I get when I buy an Amalie Labradoodle?

Your puppy will have been raised and cared for in our home til 8 weeks You will know what sort of coat your pup will have and to the best of our ability, we will aim to estimate his adult size.

	What’s included?	Notes
	De-sexing at 7 weeks	You receive a certificate from our vet and pup has a tattoo in the ear for easy identification. A thorough vet health check is done at this time.
	Micro-chipping	You will receive a certificate in the post – no more to do!
	Age appropriate vaccinations & worming	A vaccination certificate is supplied with a schedule of when the next vaccination is due.
	Flea and tick treatment	Given at 6 weeks – it covers pup till 10 weeks of age
	Registration with ALA	An ALA certificate will be emailed to you within a few weeks
	3 year health guarantee	Please read our info sheet and contract for more details
	Amalie Pedigree	In most cases we provide a 5 generation pedigree for our pups. If there is ever a query of parentage, verification is possible as both parents are registered with a national DNA database.
	Puppy care notes and our ongoing support	Comprehensive notes providing a good range of introductory information to help you an your puppy settle in at home.
	Basic training and socialisation	As pups are raised in our home household noise and activity will be the norm for these guys from a young age.

News Flash! We are also developing a Grooming DVD that provides general grooming advice and runs through some basics on clipping – Jezzie is a beautifully behaved grooming model!
