

# Amalie Labradoodles – Puppy Export



## We would like an Amalie puppy and live outside Australia – what do we do?

Please send us an email and we will send you a “**Wish-list**” application. Return the completed form by email and we will acknowledge receipt of your request. At this time we will usually be able to give you an indication of when a puppy that meets your needs might be available. Each application joins the list in turn and puppies are subsequently offered in turn according to the specifics of your request and what is available.



## What costs are involved?

In general additional costs will be required for boarding, health care, export permits and clearances, travel and import to the country of destination. On arrival there may be additional fees associated with clearance of the puppy from the national authorities. As each country is different and fees are subject to change, please contact us for an indicative quotation. This may need to be revised closer to the puppy’s travel date.

You will be responsible for investigating what costs and logistics are involved in the country you will be importing the puppy to. You may also need to arrange relevant documentation or permits and you will need to make arrangement for payment of any in-country fees. These will be in addition to any quotation provided by Amalie Labradoodles.



## What costs are covered by the quotation from Amalie?

All Amalie companion puppies are desexed, microchipped, age appropriately vaccinated, wormed and checked by a vet. They are registered with the Australian Labradoodle Association and come with a pedigree, 3 year health guarantee and our commitment to ongoing support and advice as needed. When?	What you can expect to usually be covered by the Amalie Quotation?
<b>Before departure</b>  <i>Managed by Amalie in conjunction with Dogtainers or Jepets</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Boarding (including socialization and basic training) with Amalie until puppy is old enough to travel (minimum age is 12 weeks)</li><li>• All health care (vaccinations, internal and external parasite treatment)</li><li>• Preparation of export documentation including Australian Health Certificate</li><li>• Crate training in preparation for travel. The crate is yours to keep.</li><li>• Any boarding, transport or handling managed by AQIS or the carrier (Dogtainers or Jetpets) immediately prior to export</li><li>• Australian customs and quarantine clearance</li></ul>
<b>In transit</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Air transportation in an IATA approved pet crate by most direct route</li><li>• Puppy’s water supply to be topped up as appropriate</li></ul>



## What costs are NOT covered by the quotation from Amalie?

Our quotation does not cover insurance, transportation from the airport to a final destination or any in-country fees on arrival. Customs clearance, quarantine inspection and airport terminal fees cannot be pre-paid and need to be arranged in-country by you, as the buyer.



## What else do I need to know?

For your pups travel, we aim to get the best service at competitive rates. We consider transit times and carrier - we may recommend a more expensive quote for the welfare of your pet and electronic copies of documentation.
